











COUNTY PROFILE



West Pokot County has a total land area of 9,123 Square Kilometers. The County has a population of 621,241 with a 1.9% change in population per year. The County's population is distributed as follows:-

(a) West Pokot -184,446 (b) Pokot South -183,294 (c) Pokot North -134,485 (d) Pokot Central -119,016

The population is dominated by the young at 51.1%. Literacy level is as low as 33% while 94.9% of residents live in rural areas. The County has a poverty rate of 57.3%.

It is strategically located to reach international markets such as Uganda and South Sudan. It also enjoys markets within NOREB counties and beyond.



- Establishment of a youth recreational centre at Makutano with an amphitheatre, recording studio, indoor games (darts, archery, table tennis, badminton and lawn tennis)
- Construction of modern stadia in all Sub-counties
- Rehabilitation of Kishaunet Show ground pitch


- Establisment of West Pokot County Marathon to build talent and raise funds for other purposes
